Re: Information Request – Freedom of Information Act 2000

Following your request for information we received on 4 December 2014. The Trust has looked into your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, but it is with regret that we are unable to provide in detail the information you have requested.

You requested the following information:

1. In the 2013/14 financial year how many times were anti-depressant drugs prescribed for the treatment of a patient under the age of 16? What was the age of the youngest patient?

The Trust does not provide a Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service, but it does however provide an Early Intervention Service which treats patients from the age of 14 years. I can confirm that the Trust did not prescribe any anti-depressant drugs for treatment of patients under the age of 16 during the financial year 2013/14.
