**Re: Information Request – Freedom of Information Act 2000**

Following your request for information we received on the 5 December 2014, we are providing you with access to the recorded information held by Camden and Islington NHS Foundation Trust in answer to your enquiry.

You requested the following information:

**“Full management structure including names for the whole IT Department in you organisation. A clear breakdown of the names and positions of all IT Programme and Project Managers within the trust and the specific programmes and projects they are overseeing.**

**Can you please provide a granular organisational chart for the IT Department, from the Director downwards.**

Please see the Trust’s attached ICT organisation chart.

**Refusal Notice**

I must advise you that the Trust is withholding your request for information for the names and positions for the whole IT Department in the Trust (with the exception of the ICT Associate Director) under section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act because it is personal information as defined in the Data Protection Act 1998, and it relates to third parties who are junior employees within the Trust. The disclosure would constitute a breach of at least one of the Data Protection Principles defined in the Data Protection Act 1998 and it would be unfair to these third parties and beyond their reasonable expectation to release this information into the public domain.

The Trust is however willing to release the name of its ICT Associate Director, namely David Jackland, who is a senior employee.

**“Also, a list of the Clinical Systems (EPR/PAS) used within the Trust.”**

I can confirm that EPR system used by the Trust is Servlec – Rio, but that it will be moving to Advance – Casenotes in the near future.

I do hope you are satisfied with the way in which your response was handled, if not you may request an internal review at the above email address within 28 days of this letter. When contacting the Trust please use the above reference that is unique to your request.

If you remain unsatisfied with the outcome of the internal review, you may seek further recourse by lodging an appeal with the Information Commissioner’ Office at Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Cheshire, SK9 5AF and on the Information Centre’s website.
