Re: Information Request – Freedom of Information Act 2000

Following your request for information we received on 22 January 2015. In answer to your queries, we are providing you with a response to your questions.

You requested the following information:

“The structure charts of your corporate departments. Specifically across – Finance, HR and any specific project teams you may have. Including the names and job titles of the relevant members of staff within the structures. Including the Senior management team, Directors and Chief Executive.”

Refusal Notice

I must advise you that the Trust is withholding the names and job titles of junior employees who are not at Associate Divisional Director level and above, under section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. This is considered to be personal information as defined in the Data Protection Act 1998, as it relates to third parties who are junior employees within the Trust. The disclosure would constitute a breach of at least one of the Data Protection Principles as defined in the Data Protection Act 1998 and it would be unfair to these individuals and beyond their reasonable expectation to release this information into the public domain.

Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 is an absolute exemption which means that the Trust is not obliged to consider whether or not it is in the public interest to release this information.

I do hope you are satisfied with the way in which your response was handled, if not you may request an internal review at the above email address within 28 days of this

letter. When contacting the Trust please use the above reference that is unique to your request.

If you remain unsatisfied with the outcome of the internal review, you may seek further recourse by lodging an appeal with the Information Commissioner' Office at Wycliffe House, Water Lane, Wilmslow, Cheshire, SK9 5AF and on the Information Centre's website. www.ico.gov.uk/
