Following your request for information we received on the 26 February 2015, we are providing you with access to the recorded information held by Camden and Islington NHS Foundation Trust in answer to your enquiry.

You requested the following information:

- “1. How many patients under-18 were admitted to adult psychiatric wards at your trust in 2013-14 and 2014-15 (so far)? For each year, how many of these patients were under-16?”**

There were no under 18 year-old patients admitted to any Camden and Islington NHS Foundation Trust wards between 1st April 2014 and 28th February 2015.

- 2. What was the a) average length of these admissions for each year and b) the longest of these admissions for each year.**

Because no such patients were admitted there is no average length of stay, and no maximum length of stay.

- 3. Please list the full names of the tier 4 inpatient children’s mental health services that your trust has arranged admissions to – or asked NHS England to arrange admission to - in 2013-14 and 2014-15?
