Re: Information Request – Freedom of Information Act 2000

Following your request for information we received on 3 December 2014. The Trust has looked into your request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000, but it is with regret that we are unable to provide in detail the information you have requested.

You requested:

Does the trust issue nutritional information to parents whose babies have feeding problems – ie problems eating lumpy foods – and/or whose babies struggle to gain weight?

What is this information?

Does the trust advise different foods in lists described as “bite and dissolve”, “bite and squash/suck” and “easy chew food suggestions”?

What foods appear on these lists?

I can confirm that this Trust does not hold the requested information because this Trust is a specialist mental health provider and it treats people with mental health problems.
