Categories of Personal Data

- Demographics, gender, age, ethnicity and race
- Student contact details, email, phone number, date of birth, address
- Next of kin name and telephone number
- Course details
- Disabilities (where relevant) related to course learning guidance conversation

Legal basis of processing

Article 6 (1)(A)

The data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purpose

Article 6 (1)(E)

Processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller.

Article 9 2(A)

The data subject has given explicit consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purpose
