Purpose of processing

The Trusts has commissioned the use of RIO. The system processes full clinical records for the trust provided MH and Community services.

This is a full record of the clients' interaction with the trust as part of the care provided, across the full intake area of the various trust services (this varies by service and commissioning)

All data relating to the patient's interaction with the trust clinical services as part of their care spell, is recorded on the system. This includes Operational information, Clinical records, and data required for statutory, operational, KPI and reporting.

Legal basis of processing

Article 9(2)(h) processing is necessary for the purposes of preventive or occupational medicine, for the assessment of the working capacity of the employee, medical diagnosis, the provision of health or social care or treatment or the management of health or social care systems and services on the basis of Union or Member State law or pursuant to contract with a health professional and subject to the conditions and safeguards
